A delivers the goods accordingly in Calcutta. In a suit by A against B for the price of goods which court has jurisdiction?
17. The judgment debtor dies before the full satisfaction of the decree. The decree holder applies to the court to execute the same against the legal representative of the deceased. The Court says it cannot. Decide.
18. In a civil suit where the plaintiff sues for mesne profits, the plaint states approximately the amount or value sued for and not the exact amount. The court rejects the plaint for this. Decide whether the court's decision is legally valid.
19. A minor decree holder claims in a court that his time for filing execution would stand extended till his disability ceases. Decide.
