- (a) The electoral college and time of election of president.
- (b) Principles of collective responsibility.
- (c) Constitutional position of governor.
- (d) Advocate general.
- (e) Holder of 'office of profit'.
- (f) Annual financial statement.
- (g) Bicameral legislature - merits and demerits.

2. Explain **any four** of the following. Each question carries **4** marks. Answer should not exceed 120 words.

- (a) Discuss the advisory jurisdiction of supreme court.
- (b) Discuss the legislative powers of the president.
- (c) Explain the 'doctrine of pleasure' with its exception.
- (d) Examine the power of granting pardon of the governor.
- (e) Examine the doctrine of " Eminent Domain".

3. Answer **any four** of the following. Each question carries **6** marks.

- (a) The government of India levies an import duty on goods imported by a state for government use. This is challenged by the state on the ground that the property of the state is immune from taxation. Decide.
- (b) The legislative assembly of the state passed a money bill and the same was transmitted to the legislative council for its recommendation. The legislative council retained the same for 12 days and rejected the same. But the legislative assembly of the state accepted the same without considering the decision of the legislative council. Decide.
- (c) 'X' being inducted into central cabinet without being a member of either House of parliament. He could not succeed in the election. Thereafter he was again appointed as minister for another period of 6 months. Decide.
- (d) 'X' secured a job in govt. service by producing a false certificate and he was dismissed from the service. Is he protected by article 311 of the constitution of India.
- (e) 'X' a member of parliament files a nomination as candidate for the election of the vice president of India without resigning the post of member of parliament. Is it proper? Give reasons.

4. Answer **any three** of the following. Each question carries **10** marks.

- (a) Discuss how the exercise of emergency powers under Indian Constitution when 'failure to constitutional machinery and financial emergency'.
- (b) Examine the provisions under Indian constitution deals with "Trade, commerce and intercourse within the territory of India".

- (c) Examine the writ Jurisdiction of High courts and supreme courts under Indian constitution.
- (d) What are the nature and distribution of legislative powers between union and states?
- (e) What are the powers and functions of Election commission of India.
