- Proportional representation by single transferable vote
- Attorney General of India
- Proterm Speaker
- Contempt of court
- Doctrine of pith and substance
- Doctrine of 'eminent domain'
- Money Bills.

II. Explain **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **4** marks. Answer should **not exceed 120 words each**.

- Explain the ordinance making power of the governor.
- Discuss the procedure for impeachment of President under Indian Constitution.
- Examine the qualification and disqualifications of Members of Parliament.
- Write a note on Election Commission of India.
- Discuss the powers and duties of Comptroller and Auditor General of India.

III. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

- 'X', appointed as a Chairman of the Board of School Education in a State on Honorarium basis. Whether the 'holder of office' can be a disqualification on the ground of 'office of profit' ?



- b) A railway worker was convicted on a charge of disorderly drunken and indecent behaviour on a railway platform. Rule 14 of the Railway servants (Appeals and Discipline) provided that any penalty is imposed on railway servants on the ground of misconduct which has led to conviction on a criminal charge, the disciplinary authority may consider the circumstances and makes such other order thereon as it deems fit'. Accordingly the railway authority without giving an opportunity of hearing dismissed him from service. Decide.
- c) A person practices for a period of 7 years and become a District Judge. He holds the office of District Judge for 5 years. Will he qualify for the appointment of a High Court Judge ?
- d) 'A' grows tea and transport it to Kolkata via Assam. Assam State Legislature passed a law imposing tax on goods carried by road and inland waterways. Is 'A' liable to pay Tax ? Give reasons.
- e) 'X', a government servant was appointed to officiate a higher post. After one year he was reverted to original post on the ground of unsatisfactory work. 'X' challenge this under Article 311 of the Constitution. Will he succeed ? Give reasons. **(4×6=24 Marks)**

- b) Examine the constitutional position and powers of the President of India.
- c) Discuss the procedure for the Amendment of the Constitution with the help of decided cases.
