III. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

- a) A person is elected simultaneously as a Member of Legislative Assembly as well as Member of Lok Sabha. Does law allow him/her to continue as Member of both the houses ? Decide.
- b) Three Members of Parliament belonging to the CMM Party accepted bribe and voted against Non-confidence motion in the Parliament, in favour of ruling front. The MPs who accepted bribe have been charged under Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Relevant Provisions of IPC. The MPs claim immunity under Doctrine of Parliamentary Privilege. Decide.
- c) X a High Court Judge (retired) wants to practice as an advocate. Decide.
- d) A Statute was included by the Parliament in 9th Schedule of the Constitution by way of an amendment. Is it subject to Judicial Review ?
- e) On the recommendation of the Governor of a State President of India imposed President's Rule in that state and simultaneously dissolved the legislative assembly. Examine the validity of the action. **(4×6=24 Marks)**

IV. Answer **any three** of the following. **Each** question carries **10** marks.

- a) When is State Emergency declared ? Discuss the procedure. What are the safeguards against misuse of powers of state emergency ?
- b) Discuss various powers vested with the President under Constitution.
- c) Explain the procedure in passing various kinds of bills.
- d) Examine Jurisdiction of Supreme Court.
- e) Discuss the Constitutional Provisions relating to distribution of financial power and finance between Union and States. **(3×10=30 Marks)**
