  - (e) Void agreements.
  - (f) Wagering agreements.
  - (g) Liquidated damages.

- (a) Write a note on classification of contracts.

3. Answer any **four** of the following. Each question carries 6 marks.

- (a) S agreed to sell his house to B for Rs. 10,00,000/-, B has to pay the amount on or before 01.02.2017 and the house to be handed over on such payment to B. But on 25.01.2017 S sold the house to P for Rs. 12,00,000/- and also handed over the house to P. On 30.01.2017, B offered the agreed amount of Rs. 10,00,000/- and demanded S to sell the house to him. S informed B that he had already sold the house to P. Can S do so?
- (b) M, aged 14 years, joined a cricket coaching academy and agreed to pay Rs. 10,000/- as fee for coaching. He paid Rs. 2,000/- as advance. He received coaching as promised. When the cricket coaching academy demanded the balance amount M refused to pay it. Whether M is bound to pay the amount?
- (c) An amount of Rs. 10,000/- is due from Q to R. Z resembles R physically and thinking that Z is R, Q paid the amount to Z, on realizing the mistake Q sought to recover the amount from Z. Whether Z is bound to return?
- (d) A, an inmate of the Hostel, put up a notice in the hostel notice board that he lost his keys and would give Rs. 1000/- to anyone who finds and gives it to him. B, a friend of A gave him the keys. He demanded the award of Rs. 1000/-. Should A pay the amount?
- (e) A advanced money to his minor son B. On attaining majority by B, A by misuse of parental influence, obtained a bond of enhanced amount from B. Discuss whether B is liable to pay the amount?
