I. Explain **any five** of the following. **Each** question carries **2** marks. Answers should not exceed **50** words **each** :

- a) Proposal
- b) Consideration
- c) Consensus ad idem
- d) Doctrine of mutuality
- e) Effect of mistakes as to law
- f) Requirements of quantum meruit
- g) Liquidated damages.

II. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **4** marks. Answers should not exceed **120** words **each** :

- a) Define undue influence
- b) Distinguish between fraud and innocent misrepresentation
- c) Distinguish between legal assignment and equitable assignment
- d) Doctrine of novation
- e) Recession of contracts.

III. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks :

- a) A and B agree that A shall sell B a house for 10,000 rupees, but that, if B uses it as a gambling house, he shall pay A 50,000 rupees for it. Decide the enforceability of the contract.
- b) A promises to B to drop a prosecution which he has instituted against B for robbery and B promises to restore the value of the things taken. Decide whether the agreement is valid.



- ✓ c) A owes B Rs. 1,000/- but the debt is barred by the limitation Act. A signs a written promise to pay B Rs. 500/- on account of the debt. Decide the validity of the contract.
- ✓ d) A promises to paint a picture for B by a certain day, at a certain price. A dies before the day. Decide the enforceability of the contract.
- e) A employ B as a contractor to construct his house at certain agreed rates. B hopes to make a profit of Rs. 500/- on the completion of the work. Before the work is half done A terminates his contract with B alleging that the work turned out by B was not good. B files a suit for a permanent injunction restraining A from getting the house built with the aid of others. Can the court grant B the reliefs prayed for ? **(4×6=24 Marks)**

IV. Answer **any three** of the following. **Each** question carries **10** marks :

- a) Explain the doctrine of frustration and the limitation to it.
- b) Define public policy and explain the current trends and recognized categories of public policy.
- c) Explain the importance of standard form of contracts.
