PART – C

Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

1. A dentist agrees to make artificial teeth for a person and fit them in to his mouth – Is it a Contract of Sale ?
2. A's ornaments having been stolen were recovered by the police and while in police custody, they were stolen again. Can 'A' take action against the police ?
3. 'A' and 'B' were partners under an agreement, which provided that partnership could be terminated by mutual arrangement only. Now 'A' alone wants to terminate the partnership. Can he do so ?
4. 'A' obtains a loan from a co-operative society for which 'B' is the guarantor. The society waived repayment of loan. Explain 'B's liability as a surety.
5. 'A' without authority buys goods for 'B'. 'B' sells part of these goods to 'X' on his own account and as regards the rest of the goods he denies A's authority to buy for him. Decide.

1. Explain different methods by which partnership can be dissolved.
2. Define Bailment and enumerate the rights and duties of bailee.
3. Describe briefly the various modes by which an agency may be terminated.
4. "Section 124 and 125 of the Indian Contract Act 1872 are not exhaustive of the law of Indemnity" – Discuss.
5. Explain the rules relating to the passing of the property in the goods under the Sale of Goods Act.
