 - d) What is procedure of recording a confession ?
 - e) When does a person apply for anticipatory bail ? **(4×4=16 Marks)**



III. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

- a) A is tried for causing grievous hurt and convicted. The person injured dies afterwards. Can A be tried for culpable homicide again.
- b) P is accused of having committed theft on 1st Jan. 2013. P is accused of committing theft on 1st Feb. 2013 and 1st March 2013. P is charged together with respect to these three accusations. Examine the validity.
- c) During the trial of a case Judicial Magistrate First Class Court is satisfied that the final disposal of the case involves the validity of an Act, Ordinance or Regulation. What is course of action for the Magistrate ?
- d) A Chief Judicial Magistrate directs a warrant to a private person within the jurisdiction of CJM for the arrest of an escaped convict. Examine the validity of such an action.
- e) An Executive Magistrate receives information that X is likely to commit a wrongful act which would disturb public tranquility. What action can be taken by the Magistrate ? **(4×6=24 Marks)**
