- I. Explain **any five** of the following. **Each** question carries **2** marks. Answers should **not** exceed **50** words **each** :
- a) Mens rea
  - b) Criminal breach of trust
  - c) Public Nuisance
  - d) Abetment
  - e) Dishonestly and fraudulently
  - f) Offences against environment
  - g) Attempt to commit suicide. **(5×2=10 Marks)**
- II. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **4** marks. Answer should **not** exceed **120** words **each** :
- a) When Right to Private Defence of Body can be extended to causing of death ?
  - b) Difference between the offences of sexual harassment and stalking.
  - c) Difference between kidnapping and abduction.
  - d) Intoxication as a defence for criminal liability.
  - e) Ingredients of dowry death.
  - f) Force and criminal force. **(4×4=16 Marks)**



III. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks :

- a) 'X' by putting 'Z' in fear of grievous hurt, dishonestly induces 'Z' to sign or affix his seal in a blank paper and delivers it to 'X'. 'Z' signs and delivers the paper to 'X'. What is the liability of 'X' ?
- b) 'A' appear as a witness before 'B', a magistrate. 'B' says that he does not believe a word of A's deposition and that 'A' has perjured himself. 'A' is moved to sudden passion by these words and kills 'B'. What is the offence committed ?
- c) 'A' instigates 'B' to murder 'D'. 'B' in pursuance of the instigation stabs 'D'. 'D' recovers from the wound. Has 'A' committed any offence.
- d) 'A', a surgeon knowing that a particular operation is likely to cause the death of 'Z' who suffers under painful complaint performs operation and 'Z' dies. Whether the surgeon is liable for murder.
- e) 'A' meets 'Y' on high road. Showing a pistol 'A' demands Y's purse. 'Y' surrenders his purse. What is the offence committed. **(4×6=24 Marks)**

- a) What is meant by defamation ? What are the exceptions ?
- b) What are the general exceptions or defences from criminal liability ?
- c) What are the difference between theft and extortion ?
- d) What are the offences relating to marriage ? **(3×10=30 Marks)**
