 - (f) Criminal trespass.
 - (g) Abetment.

2. Answer **any four** of the following. Each question carries 4 marks. Answer should not exceed 120 words each.
- (a) Point out the constituent elements of a crime.
 - (b) Explain the distinction between preparation and attempt.
 - (c) Write a short note on extra-territorial jurisdiction.
 - (d) Explain culpable homicide.
 - (e) What is criminal misappropriation?
 - (f) Explain the term 'voluntarily'.

3. Answer **any four** of the following. Each question carries 6 marks.

- (a) P attacks R. R, for protecting his life, takes his gun and attempts to shoot P. On seeing this P starts running. R shoots him resulting in the death of P. R is charged for causing death of P. Decide.
- (b) A takes an article belonging to B without his consent and with the intention to receive reward from B on its restoration. Discuss whether the act done by A is an offence?
- (c) X instigated Y to kill Z. Y in pursuance stabs Z. But Z recovers from the injury. What is the liability of X?
- (d) A induces X to give him money by threatening to publish a defamatory libel concerning X. What is the offence committed by A?
- (e) A, a tax officer entered a shop to inspect the account books for verification and started examining the account books kept therein. B, the owner of the shop snatched the books from A. Has B committed any offence? Discuss.

4. Answer **any three** of the following. Each question carries 10 marks each.

- (a) Explain the general defences and exceptions available under IPC.
- (b) Write an essay on offences by public servants.
- (c) Define defamation. Explain the essential ingredients to constitute the offence of defamation.
- (d) Who is an abettor? Discuss the liability when an act is abetted and a different act is committed.
