- (c) B intentionally pulls up a woman's veil without her consent. What offence has A committed?
- (d) A instigates B to commit theft at C's house. After committed theft, B rapes a girl in C's house. Discuss the liability of A and B.
- (e) A, a police officer, with the warrant of the court arrests B. bonafidely believing to B to be Z. Whether A has committed any offence?
