- g) Punishment for cheating.

- a) Sedition
- b) Undue influence at elections
- c) Adulteration of drugs
- d) Voluntarily causing grievous hurt
- e) Receiving of stolen property
- f) Sale of obscene books.

III. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

- a) A, a landholder, knowing of the commission of a murder within the limits of his estate, wilfully misinforms the magistrate of the district that the death has occurred by accident in consequence of the bite of a snake. Has A committed any offence ?



- b) Mr. A was charged for causing death of one M by contact with the electrically charged copper wire which he had fixed up at the back of his house. Has A committed any offence ?
- c) A woman jumped into a well in order to avoid and escape from her husband and subsequently came out of the well herself. Has she committed any offence ?
- d) A places men with firearms at the outlets of a building, and tells Z that they will fire at Z if Z attempts to leave the building. Discuss the liability of A.
- e) A forcibly takes the thumb impression of B on a blank piece of paper.  
Discuss the offence committed by A. **(4×6=24 Marks)**
