1. Discuss 'Divorce by Mutual Consent' under Hindu Marriage Act.
2. Discuss the provisions under Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act regarding the person who may give in Adoption.
3. Discuss the legal effect of 'valid' and 'irregular' marriage under Muslim Law.
4. Explain the right of custody of child of the guardian under Muslim Law.
5. Examine the essential requirements of a valid marriage under Special Marriage Act. **(4×4=16 Marks)**



PART – III

Answer **any four** questions. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

1. 'X' a Hindu married to 'Y' who at the time of marriage was already having a wife. 'C' brings an action by way of a suit for declaration of nullity of marriage as per the provision of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. Do you agree with this? Advise 'C'.
2. 'X' the father of a Hindu Minor, sold the property of the minor and used the amount for the benefit of minor with out prior permission of the Court. Is the sale valid? Would it make any difference when the property is a share in Coparcenary property?
3. A Muslim divorced his wife by pronouncing 'Talak'. He remarries the same divorced wife after five years and divorced her again. A child was born out in the second marriage. She approached you to claim for getting maintenance to her and the child. Advise.
4. The deceased father's brother contracted the marriage of A, a minor Muslim girl with a minor Muslim boy. Is the girl entitled to get an option of puberty? Give reasons.
5. Can two Hindus marry under Special Marriage Act, 1954? Discuss the advantages and consequences of that marriage solemnised under the Special Marriage Act. **(4x6 = 24 Marks)**

PART – IV

Answer **any three** questions. **Each** question carries **10** marks. Answer should **not** exceed **300** words.

1. Discuss the effect of adoption under Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act. Examine whether the doctrine of "relation back theory has been recognised under Hindu Adoption".
2. Explain the nature of 'dower' under Muslim Law and state how dower can be enforced.
3. Briefly examine the grounds of Divorce under dissolution of Muslim Marriage Act, 1939.
4. What is meant by Maintenance Pendente lite' and 'Permanent alimony'? How it is dealt under Hindu Marriage Act, 1955? **(3x10 = 30 Marks)**
