Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

1. X entrusted Y for clearing small forest in his land. While doing the work. Y found a gold chain and kept with him without informing X. Later X came to know about the incident and demanded the gold chain back. Y refused to deliver the gold chain because X is not the true owner of the chain. Decide.
2. A person named 'Z' died unexpectedly due to cardiac arrest. He was living a lonely life away from his legal heirs. He died without making a will. 'Z' was in rivalry with his legal heirs because of which Z did not receive a decent burial. During the partition of Z's property, a conflict occurred between the legal heirs and the incidents led to the damage of reputation of 'Z', 'Y', a friend of 'Z' gave a complaint to protect the reputation of 'Z'. Legal heirs together took a position in response that the dead person has no right and Y has no *locus standi* to file such a complaint against legal heirs. Decide.
3. Mr. 'X' incorporated an aviation company where he held 2999 out of 3000 shares. He was the sole director of the company and was also employed as a pilot in the company. He has killed in a plane crash during the course of his employment. Mrs. 'X', wife of Mr. 'X' sued the company for compensation. Decide.
4. A public interest litigation was filed in Honourable Supreme Court of India by 'Centre against Death Penalty', an Academic Centre in one of the prominent law schools in India, for declaring death penalty unconstitutional. Decide.
5. A temple follows a ritual where children below the age of 15 years was paraded in a condition where their cheeks are pierced with a sacred iron rod. This ritual is followed as part of their faith believing that by doing so their family gets wealth and fame. A public spirited citizen approached Honourable Supreme Court of India against this custom. Decide.
