3. In a village, there existed a custom of performing certain religious rituals before the inauguration of new ventures. 'A' challenges before court that the custom is unreasonable and it has no co-relation with success of venture. Discuss.
4. There was a burial ground in a village and a poisonous tree was planted near its boundary. A horse grazing in the nearby meadow died of eating poisonous leaves of that tree. Discuss the liability of owner of burial ground.
5. A person unknowingly violated the provisions of Essential Commodities Act and stocked foodgrains beyond permitted limit. Is he criminally liable ? Discuss.
