13. Adil agrees to pay Binto Rs. 5,00,000 to refrain from testifying in a court case. Binto complies but Adil refuses to pay. Can Binto enforce the contract?

14. Bimal selects a laptop from an electronics store's display, proceeds to the counter, and offers to pay the listed price. The store manager refuses to sell, citing a pricing error on the display. Can Bimal enforce the sale?
15. Alfred contracts with Betty, a transporter, to deliver a machine part to Alfred's factory by June 15, 2024. Alfred does not inform Betty that the factory will shut down without the part. Betty delivers the part on June 20, causing a five-day factory closure and a loss of Rs. 5,00,000 in profits. Alfred sues Betty for damages. Decide.
16. Anto agrees to pay Rs. 50,000 to Bose, provided Bose does not marry Chinki. Decide whether Bose can enforce the contract against Anto?
17. P, a plumber, mistakenly repairs a leak in Q's house, believing it belongs to R, who had contracted P. Q, aware of the mistake, allows P to complete the work and later refuses to pay, claiming no contract exists. P sues Q for payment. Can P recover payment?
