 2. Pooja had a pet dog. One day Ramesh, a neighbor approached Pooja and told her that unless she gives him Rs. 2,000, he will violently kick her dog. Pooja therefore gave him Rs. 2,000. Examine the offence if any committed by Ramesh.
 3. Sooraj who was suffering from chickenpox appeared for a PSC examination without wearing PPE kit. The other candidates made complaints against him on his action. Examine the offence if any committed by him.
 4. Ram and Gopal were on inimical terms. One day when Ram was walking through the road, Gopal rushed towards him with a drawn knife to injure him. Though Ram did not notice this, Shekhar, a police man noticed it. Before Gopal reach Ram, Shekhar interfered, and overpowered Gopal. Later Ram came to know about it and made a complaint against Gopal of assault. Decide.

5. Geetha, a woman went to a temple for offering prayers there. Then a VVIP made a surprise visit there. The security persons of the VVIP compelled Geetha to go out from the temple for a period of 15 minutes. She made a complaint of abduction. Decide.
