3. A client says to B an Advocate, "I wish to obtain possession of property by use of a forged deed on which I request you to sue". Is this communication protected?
4. During the celebration of Holi, accused fired the deceased Raghav. On hearing the sound A and B arrived at the spot and they learned from by standers that Kesav, the accused had fired the deceased. Explain the relevancy of depositions of A,B and the bystanders in this case.
5. The wife saw the murder. She refuses to give evidence. Can she be compelled to give evidence against her husband?
