II. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **4** marks. Answer should **not exceed 120 words each**.

- a) UDHR is considered as the 'Magna Carta' of Human Rights. Comment.
- b) Explain custom as a source of international law.
- c) Bringout the relationship between international law and municipal law.
- d) The theory that States are the only subjects of international law cannot be accepted today in all respects. Discuss.
- e) Define treaty. Explain steps in the formation of a treaty.

III. Answer **any four** of the following. **Each** question carries **6** marks.

- a) Russia nationalized the timber industry. After nationalization, a part of timber already nationalized by Russia was brought to England by a Russian agent. The original owner of the timber instituted a suit in England to declare that all the timber brought by the Russian agent to England was his property. Decide.
- b) The wife of a diplomat belonging to State 'X' was caught red handed in a theft case in State 'Y'. She was arrested by the police. Whether the wife of the diplomat can claim diplomatic immunity ? Give reasons.
- c) A ship belonging to State 'A' got damaged by a mine while passing through the territorial waters of State 'B'. State 'A' claims compensation from State 'B'. Decide.
- d) The Swiss Government asked for extradition of Mr. Thomas Hardy who was charged with murdering a member of State Council of a Swiss occupied territory. Political dissatisfaction was prevailing in that territory and Mr. Thomas Hardy was belonging to a rival political party. Advise Mr. Thomas Hardy.
- e) State 'X' made an international agreement with State 'Y' for providing 5 billion barrels of crude oil within 6 months. After two months civil war broke out in State 'Y', as a result all the oil wells got destroyed. State 'X' claims damage from State 'Y' for non-compliance of agreement. Advise State 'Y'.
