17. Some packages of tobacco belonging to A had been pledged to a bank but they were still lying in A's go down. The godown was locked and the key was given to the bank. Owing to the non payment of some income tax dues by A, the said goods were attached by the Collector and the seized goods were kept in the same go down. The go down was locked and the keys were handed over to the police. Due to heavy rains the roof of the godown leaked and the goods kept inside were damaged. Can the State be liable for the loss of goods?

18. ABC Co. Ltd agreed to supply 50 tons of apple juice by samples to D and it was agreed that the delivery is to be made in weekly truckloads. The Company crushed all the apples they had for the season and put the juice in casks to enable them to ensure that they were according to the samples. After some installments were delivered, D refused to take further deliveries. The apple juice became putrid and had to be destroyed. ABC Co. Ltd claimed the recovery of the price of the apple juice destroyed. Decide.
19. "X" guaranteed the conduct of the manager of a bank. The bank later raised his salary on the condition that he would be liable on discounts allowed by him. This matter was not communicated to X. The manager allowed a customer to over draw and the bank suffered a loss as a result. Can X be held liable?
