4. Examine the law relating to protection of women from domestic violence.
5. Explain the property rights of Hindu women. **(4×4=16 Marks)**

1. A film exhibited in theaters based on certain religious saga was alleged by some women associations as depicting the figure of woman indecently and thereby injuring public morality and demanded prohibition of it. Decide.
2. The cyber cell authorities monitored the email, posts and other activities of a woman in the social media regularly in connection with the enquiry of a crime committed by one of her acquaintances. Is this amount to violation of her right to privacy, if so state the liability of the authorities.
3. The hotel association of India challenged the legislation prohibiting employment of women in hotels and bars for serving liquor as violative of Article 14 and gender equality. Decide.
4. A divorced Muslim woman approached the court claiming maintenance for her children after the expiration of the period of iddat. Will she succeed ?
5. X a married Hindu woman without reasonable excuse left the matrimonial home. What is the legal remedy available to the husband in such situation ?
