 - (c) A popular T V Channel discloses the identity of a celebrity victim of sexual offence without her consent. Is an offence made out. Decide.
 - (d) Indian Foreign Service rules provided that no married woman has the automatic right to be appointed to the Service and that a woman employee must get written permission to marry and may be forced to resign if the Government decides that her marital commitments will hamper her work. Examine the constitutional Validity of Above Regulations.
 - (e) A pregnant woman employee at her advanced stage of pregnancy applies for Maternity leave for 6 weeks prior to delivery. The sanctioning authority refused the same. Decide.
