Mar Gregorios College of Law was established in the year 2012 by the Malankara Syrian Catholic Church under the patronage of His Beatitude Moran Mor Baselios Cardinal Cleemis Catholicos, the Major Archbishop of Malankara Catholic Church, in commemoration of the legacy and services of Late Archbishop Benedict Mar Gregorios. The College, envisaged as a centre of excellence in legal education, provides a comprehensive programme of legal education, consisting of B.A LL.B, BBA LL.B and B.Com. LL.B as well as an LL.M course in Constitutional Law)

The college is located in an eco-friendly campus in the prestigious "Mar Ivanios Vidyanagar" that creates serene ambience for academic pursuits. Having excelled in all different streams of educational service, the Malankara Catholic Education Society under the dynamic and benevolent leadership of His Beatitude Moran Mor Baselios Cardinal Cleemis, Catholicos, the Major Archbishop - Catholicos of Trivandrum, decided to establish a 'College of Law' in the campus in commemoration of His Grace Most Reverend Archbishop Benedict Mar Gregorios, who was the second Metropolitan Archbishop of the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church. Besides being the first principal of Mar Ivanios College and a spiritual leader, Archbishop Benedict Mar Gregorios was a great linguist, an economist, an educationalist par excellence and above all, a profound humanist who epitomized love and compassion. It is indeed an honour and privilege that this college of law has been named after such a great and noble soul who embodied in himself the eternal verities of Dharma, The Law.

ACHIEVEMENTS

(a) Institutional excellence Award

By the Grace of the Almighty Lord, ever since its establishment, the College, under the patronage and blessings of His Beatitude Moran Mor Baselios cardinal Cleemis Catholicos, the

Major Archbishop of Trivandrum, has grown leaps and bounds and today it is one of the most pioneer and sought after institution in its field. Within a short span of 5 years our college has bagged the prestigious SILF-MILAT INSTITUTIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD -2017. The award is instituted by the SILF-MILAT (Society of Indian law Firms (SILF) and Menon Institute of Legal Advocacy Training (MILAT) to identify and honour the best law teaching Institution in the country. Our college is the first college in Kerala and eighth in the country to get the award. His Beatitude Moran Mor Baselios cardinal Cleemis Catholicos along with Academic Advisor of the college Prof. (Dr.) K. Vikraman Nair received the award from the Chief Justice of India on 23/11/2017 in the presence of jury members of the award committee.

(c) LOK Adalat (26/8/2017)

As a part of our non-academic programme, we have organized a Lok adalat in association with Trivandrum District Legal Service Authority for the citizen of Vilappil gram Panchayat on Saturday the 26th August 2017. Hon'ble Justice Shri P. Ubaid, High Court of Kerala. Inaugurated the adalat. In the inaugural function, Shri I.B Sathish M.L.A gave the presidential address and His Excellency Most Rev. Samuel Mar Irenios, Auxiliary bishop of Trivandrum gave the Key note address. Chief Judicial Magistrate N.K Prabhakar, Vilappil Sala Panchayat President Shri Vijayaraj, Trivandrum District legal service authority chairman K.Haripal, Sub-Judge Shiju Shaik also spoke on the occasion. Lok Adalat are one of the alternate dispute resolution method to resolve the disputes between individuals where both parties can resolve the dispute with the help of mediators and the order passed in the adalat are final and binding on both the parties.

The process last over a month. House to house campaign were carried out and complaints and litigations were collected in person by students who participated in the adalat. Out of 600 litigations, 300 were listed for settlement and final verdict were passed in 136 cases on the final day i.e on 26th August 2017.

(d) First National Law Reform competition (FNLRC) - 9/12/2017

Our college in association with Menon Institute of Legal Advocacy Training (MILAT) conceived and organised First National Law Reform Competition (FNLRC) 2017 with the aim of evolving a Draft Uniform Civil Code in consonance with the efforts of the Law Commission of India. The duration of this competition was well over eight months of sustained academic research involving 150 students from reputed Institutions from all over India.

Valedictory Function of the First National Law Reform Competition for Law students on Draft Uniform Civil code for India was held on 9/12/2017. Our Patron, His Beatitude Moran Mor Baselios Cleemis Catholicos presided over the function and His Excellency Most Rev.Dr.Samuel mar Irenios gave the felicitation address. In the function, Shri Justice (Rtd.) P.Sadasivam, the Hon'ble Governor of Kerala distributed the prizes to the winners of the competitions. The draft Uniform Civil Code prepared by students as part of the competition has been handed over to the Chairman, Law Commission of India Mr. Justice G.S Chauhan by the Hon'ble Governor of Kerala. Low Commission chairman Justice G.S Chauhan and MILAT Chairman Prof.(Dr.)N.R Madhava Menon also spoke on the occasion.

Our faculty members have also been keen on research and development. We have had several achievements through our faculty members. Faculty members were invited for various programmes as resource persons. They have also published in various journals and newspapers. Research fellowships were awarded in the foreign universities along with giving assistance to UN Human Rights Committee member.

The College is perfectly placed to give its students a competitive advantage in professional excellence through the expertise of these blessed faculty.

College Journal

As part of our constant endeavor to enhance the quality of Legal learning and to encourage a culture of legal research, we have been striving to bring forth a Research Law Journal and we have succeeded in our endeavor. The first edition of "Journal of Mar Gregorios College of Law (JMGCL)" has been released on 27th November 2017 in a memorable function by our patron. The journal contains 16 Articles scripted by eminent personalities of the society and leading scholars of reputed centres including 5 professors of our college.

Infrastructure Development

Accommodated initially in the erstwhile Minor seminary building, the college is now constructing an additional block to meet the class room requirements. All the essential modification to the main building which was initially designed for the Minor seminary have been completed except that of the conversion of library hall and faculty rooms. We are planning to develop ourselves into a research center and in this regard we are extensively developing our library. We have now included a variety of books including the full volumes of Commonwealth Law Bulletin and Harvard Law Review. Entire work of Ground floor and first floor has been completed and are being used as classrooms. Construction work of the new block is in the final stage. 80% of construction work of third floor has been completed. We are also planning to erect an all-encompassing auditorium adjacent to the annex building being newly constructed to organize various events in the college which is in addition to the state of the art seminar hall which we have already developed.

<u>Conference Hall</u>. The College has a spacious air-conditioned conference hall which hosts academic programmes, seminars, debates, competitions and other activities. The hall provides a space for institutional and departmental functions and is equipped with the latest audio-visual technology, with specialized staff to handle the equipment.

Moot Court Hall. By Integrating the theory and practice of Law through Moot Court and Mock Trial activities, the college aims to sharpen the layering skills of the students. The college is equipped with a state of the art Moot Court Hall capable of hosting even international Moot Court Competitions. The second internal moot court competition was conducted from 21st

January to 24th January 2018. A moot court society has been formed and inaugurated on 24th January 2018.

Computer Lab and internet facility

Ours is a Wi-fi enabled campus with a fully equipped computer Lab with high bandwidth internet connection. Separate faculty in charge of computer lab will train the students online and offline database usage.

Praver Hall.

A prayer hall, built in the form of a chapel inside the college, provides a place for staff and students to spend time calmly & quietly in solemn prayer and introspection. In addition to daily prayers, Holy Mass is being conducted on first Friday of every month which is attended by about 100 students and members of Christian community. Members of Malankara community offers the Holy Rosary Worship especially during the Rosary month. Jesus youth Ministry is also active in our campus involving students from all communities to participate in the institutional and individual transformation.

Exam Hall

A common exam hall has been erected on the roof of the main building to meet the examination purposes, which can accommodate about 300 students at a time.

CC TV Surveillances.

In compliance to the directions of University of Kerala, all the examination halls/rooms and public places of the college has been brought under CCTV surveillances. As desired by University, the entire process of examinations being recorded and kept in safe custody to produce before the University authorities when ever asked for.

New Block for 12 class rooms.

Construction of a new Block measuring 22,206 Sq Ft with provision for 12 class rooms and allied facilities has started in the month of October 2015. Entire work of Ground floor and first floor has been completed and being used as classrooms. 80% of construction work of third floor has been completed. The roof of the building is being designed to be converted as a hall useful for various purpose. These work will be completed immediately on availability of required fund.

Students Achievement

We have a vibrant student community which is proactive in the development of the college. They ensure their positions among top ranks in each and every semester examinations, thereby bringing laurels to the Institution. Besides academic excellence, they represented the college in various National level Moot Court Competitions and also Model United Nations. They have won prizes in various other academic events including quiz competitions. They have presented papers in various National seminars around the state. In the cultural arena also the students have won lot of laurels in various competitions in the state. In the sports arena too our students have started to let know their presence in cricket, football and athletics.

Hon'ble Justice Shri P. Ubaid, High Court of Kerala. Inaugurated the adalat. In the inaugural function, Shri I.B Sathish M.L.A gave the presidential address and His Excellency Most Rev. Samuel Mar Irenios, Auxiliary bishop of Trivandrum gave the Key note address. Chief Judicial Magistrate N.K Prabhakar, Vilappil Sala Panchayat President Shri Vijayaraj, Trivandrum District legal service authority chairman K.Haripal, Sub Judge Shiju Shaik also spoke on the occasion. Lok Adalat are one of the alternate dispute resolution method to resolve the disputes between individuals where both parties can resolve the dispute with the help of mediators and the order passed in the adalat are final and binding on both the parties.

The process last over a month. House to house campaign were carried out and complaints and litigations were collected in person by students who participated in the adalat. Out of 600 litigations, 300 were listed for settlement and final verdict were passed in 136 cases on the final day i.e on 26th August 2017.

2013-14	Conference Hall. Prepared a spacious air-conditioned conference hall which could hosts academic programmes, seminars, debates, competitions and other activities. The hall provides a space for institutional and departmental functions and is equipped with the latest audio-visual technology.
2014-15	Computer Lab and Administrative office. One fully equipped computer Lab with high bandwidth internet connection and one Administrative office has been set up.
2015-16	One Exam hall. A common exam hall has been erected on the roof of the main building to meet the examination purposes, which can accommodate about 300 students at a time. All the examination halls/rooms and public places of the college has been brought under CCTV surveillances. New Block of College. Construction work of new block of College consisting of 12 class rooms and 3 faculty room in a three storied building commenced.
2016-17	New Block of College. 70% of work of new block is completed. Boring and Construction of Well. An old pond available in the premises has been converted to a well by digging and erecting rings which helped to meet the water requirement during summer. 2017-18	New Block of College. Entire work of Ground floor, and first floor has been completed and the class rooms are being used. 80 % of work of second floor have been completed. Roof of the building is designed to be used as a hall for various purposes, 60% of work of which since completed. Remaining work will be completed on availability of required fund. College canteen. A New canteen building has been constructed adjacent to the main building. The canteen has a seating capacity of 400 students and equipped with all required amenities/facilities

Novelty introduced this Year

- 3. Instances of drug abuse by students also noticed and all possible measures have been taken to eradicate it at root level. Every single case is attended to confidentially. Senior faculty, counselors and parents join hands in protecting and helping students in freeing themselves from the grip of drug addiction .. Many such students are now leading a very healthy and blissful life and helps the college and students to eradicate the menace from College and society.
- 3. A most court society has been formed in the college with a view to help students to achieve most court expertise. Students are being given essential coaching to participate in various most court competitions being organized by other centres.

Students Initiative

1. Eco Club

Students have formed an Eco Club in the College with a view to create environmental awareness especially among the younger generation. It gives student a platform to think, express and exhibit their effort towards protection of nature and inculcating ethical strong values combining with academic and eco-friendly activities in the campus.

2. Okhi Relief mission.
