## ABSTRACT AND RESEARCH PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Authors are requested to prepare their abstract and paper submissions and send a soft copy through email at [hsenec@mgcl.ac.in](mailto:hsenec@mgcl.ac.in) {Authors are requested to adhere to the following guidelines.}:

1. Every paper must be accompanied by a cover page, which should include the title of the paper, name(s) of the author(s) and their affiliations, resident country and the complete postal and email addresses and telephone numbers of the authors.
2. The Research Papers should be in a Word Document format, Times New Roman, 12- point font size with 1.5 line spacing, 1 inch margins and APA style of referencing.
3. The Word Limit for the Research Paper is limited to 4500 words, and must include the following: Title, Objectives of the study, Methodology, Findings, Conclusion/Implications/ Recommendations. Limitations (if any), Acknowledgements (if appropriate), References, Appendices (if appropriate).
4. Abstracts should be limited to 350 words with 4 to 5 keywords.
5. The Institute has a strict anti-plagiarism policy, therefore, the authors must ensure originality of the work. Selected candidates will be informed through mail. The decision of the Review Committee regarding the selection of papers will be final and binding.
6. An accolade of the "Outstanding Paper Award" will be presented to recognize the most exceptional paper at the event.
7. Outstation presenters are welcome to participate and present their work through online platforms.
